New exhibits at Neuberger

On Sunday, don't miss the opening of The Neuberger Museum of Art's newest exhibits "Romare Bearden: Abstraction" featuring largely unknown works by the great 20th century artist Romare Bearden, including fully abstract watercolors, oil paintings, and mixed media collages produced throughout the 1950s and early 1960s. Also on view: "Janet Biggs: A Step On the Sun," a video installation documenting sulfur workers as they extract minerals from inside Indonesia's fiery Ijen volcano.
