Cristin Tierney Gallery is funding the prints' production and will ship the unframed works directly to donors. *Vote Biden* is available for minimum \$250; the net amount less sales tax and shipping fees will be given to Black Voters Matter.

Dread Scott is an interdisciplinary artist whose work encourages viewers to re-examine ideals of American society. In 1989, the US Senate outlawed his artwork and President George H. W. Bush declared it "disgraceful" because of its transgressive use of the American flag. His work has been exhibited at The Whitney Museum, MoMA/PS1, The Walker Art Center, and in galleries and on street corners. He is a 2019 Open Society Foundations Soros Equality Fellow and has received grants from United States Artists and Creative Capital Foundation. *Artnet.com* highlighted his 2019 performance, *Slave Rebellion Reenactment*, as one of the most important artworks of the decade.
